

Discover Zambia's Living Heritage Through Boma Dining at Avani Victoria Falls

Set against the banks of the Zambezi River, the Boma Dinner is an invitation to connect with the community. Guests are welcomed with a local brew before being guided through a four-course menu featuring indigenous ingredients and Pan-African staples. From the spicy, orchid-based chikanda to ifisashi - a rich peanut-and-greens stew - each dish reveals the culinary ingenuity passed down through generations.



As lanterns glow and drums begin to beat, the evening unfolds with live storytelling, bush songs and dance by local performers, including the acclaimed Amakhezi troupe. Guests are encouraged to join the dancers or take up the djembe drum themselves, creating a participatory rhythm that breaks down barriers between visitor and host.

The experience taps into a growing global appetite for experiential dining, as travellers seek more meaningful, authentic connections with the places they visit. Whether enjoying the Boma Dinner as part of a family adventure or a solo journey of discovery, guests are invited to engage with Zambia's cultural heritage in a truly immersive way.

Located just steps from Victoria Falls with unlimited guest access to the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Avani Victoria Falls provides a dynamic base for exploration, from wildlife safaris to cultural discovery. With the roar of the falls as a backdrop and tradition served by firelight, the Boma Dinner promises a night of connection, celebration and Zambian soul.
